



**LAUNCH OF A NEW TECHNOLOGY ROADMAP:  
CARBON CAPTURE AND STORAGE IN INDUSTRIAL APPLICATIONS**

Carbon capture and storage (CCS) can provide a cost-effective CO<sub>2</sub> abatement option for industry; in some sectors, it is the only means of achieving necessary deep emission reductions.

This roadmap undertakes a much-needed assessment of the potential for CCS in five industries that offer the most promise for early and/or large-scale application: high-purity CO<sub>2</sub> sources, iron and steel, cement, refineries and biomass conversion. The roadmap then sets out a vision of CCS in industrial applications up to 2050, including milestones that need to be achieved for technology, financing, policy and international collaboration.
